In 2002, IMHS expanded our business office to provide shelter for cats, while our dogs remain housed in foster homes. Our small facility allows volunteer veterinarians to provide sterilization & other care at our facility. IMHS still needs more capacity to meet the community needs.

For that reason, we are coordinating with the county & other agencies in the Mount Evans Regional Animal Center Initiative, with the goal of building an appropriately sized permanent animal shelter.
